

UNC MUSIC WORKSHOP

HS PARTICIPANT INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Registration/Check-in: Registration will be held in the lobby of Granville Towers (see map at <https://maps.unc.edu>; click “Buildings” then “Housing”) from 1:00 - 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 19. Parking will be available for unloading purposes in the lot south of Granville Towers off of West Franklin Street. Parents are encouraged to attend the Orientation Meeting at 3:00 p.m. in Kenan Music Building, Rm. 2131.

Departure: On Saturday, July 25, your family and other guests are invited to attend the Finale concert at 10:00 a.m. in the Moeser Concert Hall.

Dorm Check-out: Resident students must **check out** of their rooms **by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 25**. All luggage and belongings not needed during the final concert will remain in rooms and be transferred to vehicles after the Reception. ***All belongings must be removed from Granville Towers by 12:30 p.m.*** Students will be assessed a key charge of \$25.00 for any issued key (\$50.00 for any fob) that must be replaced or is not turned in upon departure. This charge covers a lock change, not just replacement of a key. For security reasons, lock changes are mandatory when keys are lost. Counselors will stay in the dorm with students.

Dorm Life & Curfew: Resident students stay two to a room in Granville Towers, approximately two blocks from Hill Hall (*see map*). Adult counselors stay on the same floor in the dorm with the students. All students are required to check in with the counselors each evening and remain in the dorm after a specific time, usually 10:00 p.m. All students are required to be in their assigned sleeping rooms each evening by curfew, usually 11:30 p.m. Counselors will gather students after concerts and rehearsals and escort them back to the dormitory each evening. It is the student’s responsibility to meet the counselor at the prescribed time and place.

Commuters: Commuter students being picked up will be excused to their parent or legal guardian each night at 9:15 p.m. Commuter students will walk with the residents to Granville Towers and a staff member will remain with them until their parents or guardians arrive. If commuter students have requested a parking pass, they will report to the Granville Lot in time to walk with the Workshop in the morning and will return to their cars at the end of each day. Commuters riding with parents may be dropped off at the kiosk in Swain Hall in the mornings.

Classes & Attendance: Students are required to attend all scheduled classes. If a student does not appear for a scheduled activity without prior approval, parents will be notified immediately.

Automobiles: No student attending the Workshop may operate or ride in an automobile without the specific permission of the Director. Resident students who drive their own vehicle may park at Granville Towers and must turn in their keys to the Director at check-in on Sunday. Keys will be returned in time for check-out on Saturday.

Illness/Medical Emergency: Students who feel ill or experience a medical emergency should immediately notify their counselor, instructor, or the Workshop Director. Please note your medical provider and policy information on the General Liability and Release Form so we can pass that information along immediately in the event that a doctor’s services are needed. Students with

medical difficulties will be taken to UNC Hospitals on campus and parents will be notified. (See *General Release form enclosed.*)

What to bring: Dress casually but appropriately for the university classroom environment. Shorts are acceptable. For the evening concerts, dress is informal. However, for the concluding concert presented by the students, female students should bring a skirt or dress and dress shoes, and male students should bring dress slacks, shirt and tie, dark socks and dress shoes. Bring a raincoat or umbrella for summer showers.

Resident students may bring their own sheets, pillows, blankets, towels and washcloths or opt for a linen packet at additional cost.

Linen Packs may be ordered in advance or purchased at check-in and cost \$10.00. They include:

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There are also no appliances (i.e.: hairdryers; alarm clocks, etc.) in the dorm rooms. You should also bring a washable water bottle and snacks for late-night munchies.

Meals: Meals are included in the Resident Workshop fee and are served in *The Agora*, the Granville Towers Cafeteria (see *map*). Commuting students may bring their own meals, eat off campus or purchase individual meal tickets for lunch and/or dinner in the cafeteria on a cash basis in advance or at Check-in.

Telephone Calls: In general, participants are allowed to make calls from their cell phones only in non-instructional times, e.g. during meal times, after events have concluded for the day. Counselors, however, will have their cell phones on at all times in case of an emergency. Those numbers will be provided during Orientation immediately following Check-in. If you are unable to reach your child in the event of an emergency between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., you may call a counselor's number or the main Granville Towers Office at: (919) 370-4500. The Granville Towers staff will be able to reach our counselors who can contact students.

Money: We do **NOT** recommend bringing or carrying cash in any significant amount. Students may incur a small amount of copying charges for materials they elect to learn for Cabaret or to cover music for lessons. Food deliveries to the dorm may be a cash only transaction. Otherwise, all incidental costs (which should be minimal) can be conveniently covered with a renewable debit card.

Standards of Behavior: The UNC Music Workshop provides an opportunity for highly motivated students who have a sincere desire to learn more about music to spend a week with others who share that interest. The Workshop Staff feels justified in expecting the highest standards of behavior. Occasionally, a student may fail to maintain responsible standards of behavior through curfew violations or other lapses. If, in the opinion of the Director, a student fails to demonstrate a level of maturity and commitment needed to benefit from the program, the student may be sent home. Parents will be informed when a student is dismissed. **Possession /consumption of alcohol or other illegal or controlled substances will lead to immediate dismissal.**
